The importance of positive relationships for children and young people in care is clear, however the 'how, who and when' is often driven by real and perceived barriers, resources and professional roles. Many children in care have lost their relationships in communities and once they leave care will often attempt to return to them. To identify these relationships early is crucial to nurturing them and establishing a supportive emotional and social network for when they do leave. This relationship-based practice workshop explores what this universe is, who is in it and how it can be cultivated using a social pedagogical approach.
